  - » For both emphases
  - » Non-degree track
  - » 21 units of environmental course work

### ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT EMPHASIS

- Environmental management is the current emphasis of the program
- No new courses necessary to create this emphasis

## CREATED A NEW OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY EMPHASIS

- Occupational Safety (2 new courses)
- Industrial Hygiene (3 new courses)
- Toxicology (1 course, existing)
- Intro. to ET (1 course, existing)

# CREATED A NEW COOPERATIVE WORK EXPERIENCE (INTERNSHIP) COURSE

- A mandatory 2 to 4 credit course
- For both emphases

#### CREATED A NEW 2-UNIT 40-HOUR/HAZWOPER) COURSE

- The existing 4-unit course will remain
- New 2-unit course will serve the following populations
  - » Navy personnel
  - » High school studentsat-risk
  - » Prospective employees that need the training to work in the field
- Will seek U.S. EPA certification for the course
